<p>230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS</p>	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee recognizes the value of students sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 1850.1</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee endorses public performances by students when they constitute a learning experience that contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities; and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety or well-being of the students who are involved.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Joint Operating Committee.</p> <p>The Administrative Director or designee shall develop procedures to implement this policy.</p>
<p>4. Guidelines</p>	<p>Parental permission shall be sought and received before students may participate in any public performance.</p> <p>No student, group of students, or employees of this Joint Operating Committee may receive compensation for a public performance of students organized as school representatives.</p> <p>The interests of students shall be protected and guarded against exploitation.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
