709.1. TRESPASSING/LOITERING	
1. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee establishes that the Administrative Director, Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds, Supervisor of Evening and Night Maintenance Staff, and any security officers who might be employed by the Joint Operating Committee shall be designated and authorized to take proper actions, in conjunction with the Richland Township Police Department, in the arrest and prosecution of persons apprehended trespassing or committing acts of vandalism on the center property.</p> <p>The Richland Township Police are empowered to enter onto and into school property in order to apprehend or arrest violators of trespassing rights or curfew regulations. In addition, the police shall be empowered to enforce traffic regulations on the school parking lots.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee authorizes members of the school administrative/supervisory staff or delegated individuals and school security officials, to request the Richland police or police dog warden to seize and detain any licensed or unlicensed dog found running at large on school grounds. The owner or claimant of a dog so detained shall pay a penalty as required by the political subdivision whose police officers make such seizures.</p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Administrative Director is authorized to erect signs notifying all individuals that pets are not permitted on the campus grounds.</p>
