<p>1. Authority</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">713. LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL PROPERTY</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall not be responsible for the personal property of students, employees, or other persons using the school facilities.</p> <p>Articles of clothing, jewelry, money, and other articles of a personal nature or constituting personal property such as radios, eyeglasses, etc., are the responsibility of the student, employee or person while s/he is in the school facility.</p> <p>However, the Joint Operating Committee may reimburse professional employees for any unusual damage or destruction of clothing or personal apparel of the professional employee while on duty in the center, on the center premises, or on a school-sponsored activity so long as the damage or destruction does not occur due to carelessness or negligence on the part of the professional employee. Any such reimbursement shall take into consideration any insurance recoverable.</p> <p>Items deemed necessary to carry on the educational program of the center will be furnished by the center to students, employees, and to those others using school facilities under such rules and regulations as the Joint Operating Committee may establish.</p> <p>The center will provide reasonable safeguards for the protection and safekeeping of personal property which may be brought on the premises.</p>
